A JOINT RESOLUTION FOR A MAIL ROUTE FROM WILLMAR TO NEW LONDON, IN KANDIYOHI COUNTY.

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That our senators and representatives in congress be requested to use their efforts to secure the establishment of a mail route from Willmar to New London, in Kandiyohi county.

Resolved further, That the secretary of state be requested to forward a copy of these resolutions to each of our senators and representatives in congress.

NUMBER IX.

A JOINT RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, Application is now being made to the congress of the United States for the renewal and extension of divers patent right monopolies, but more particularly the one known as the Wheeler & Wilson combination patents for sewing machines, the extension of which we deem to be the protection of an onerous monopoly; therefore,

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That we respectfully remonstrate against any further extension or renewal of such patents by the congress of the United States, and request and instruct our members of congress and senators to use all honorable efforts to defeat the same.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be instructed to forward a copy of these resolutions to our senators and representatives.
