

line between sections seven and eight, township one hundred and three, range thirty-seven, in town of West Heron Lake, being the point where the regularly laid out stage road between Heron Lake station, in said Jackson county, and Spirit Lake, Iowa, crosses said creek, and the said bridge, when erected, shall be kept in repair by the town of West Heron Lake, and be forever free from toll.

SEC. 2. The said bridge shall be built under the direction of the board of county commissioners of said Jackson county, and no part of said appropriation shall be paid of the state treasury until said bridge shall be completed and ready for travel.

SEC. 3. The governor shall appoint three persons, citizens of Jackson county, to view said bridge when completed, and examine all contracts, vouchers and accounts respecting the construction and cost of said bridge, and fix the cost thereof, and make a report of said cost to the state auditor.

SEC. 4. That upon the receipt of said report by the state auditor, he shall draw his order in favor of said county of Jackson on the state treasurer, for the cost of the bridge, not to exceed the sum of five hundred dollars, and the state treasurer shall pay over such money to the county treasurer of Jackson county, upon said order of the state auditor, and such money shall be paid out by the county treasurer of Jackson county, upon the orders of said board of county commissioners, in payment of the cost of the said bridge.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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## CHAPTER CXCI.

AN ACT TO AID THE COUNTIES OF NOBLES AND ROCK TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO CONSTRUCT BRIDGES AND OPEN AND IMPROVE THE ROAD FROM WORTHINGTON, IN NOBLES COUNTY, VIA LUVERNE, TO THE WEST LINE OF ROCK COUNTY, ON THE WORTHINGTON, LUVERNE AND SIOUX FALLS ROAD.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first money which may come into the treasury belonging to said fund, to construct bridges and open and improve the road from Worthington, in Nobles county, *via* Luverne, to the west line of Rock county, on the Worthington, Luverne and Sioux Falls road, as at present located.

SEC. 2. That said bridges shall be constructed and said road

opened and repaired, under the direction of the county commissioners of Nobles and Rock counties, and no part of said appropriation shall be paid out of the state treasury till said bridges are completed and ready for travel.

SEC. 3. That R. F. Humiston, J. B. Churchill and W. H. Halbert, of the counties of Nobles and Rock, are hereby appointed a committee on the part of the state to view said bridges when completed, and examine all contracts, vouchers and accounts respecting the construction and cost thereof, and to ascertain, compute and fix upon the cost of building said bridges, and make report of such cost to the state auditor, any two of said committee may act in the premises.

SEC. 4. That upon receipt of said report by the state auditor, he shall, upon demand of the treasurer of Nobles county, draw his order or orders in favor of said county treasurer, on the state treasurer for moneys belonging to said fund to the amount of the cost of the bridges as reported by said committee, but not to exceed five hundred dollars, and the state treasurer shall pay over such money to said county treasurer upon said orders, and such moneys shall be disbursed by said county treasurer, upon the orders of the said county commissioners aforesaid, to pay off the cost of the construction of said bridges, and the improvement of said road.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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## CHAPTER CXCH.

### AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO BUILD A BRIDGE ACROSS THE CHIPPEWA RIVER, IN GRANT COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of two hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund not already appropriated, for the building of a substantial bridge across the Chippewa river, on the mail route from Alexandria to Herman, on section fourteen, in township one hundred and twenty-eight, of range forty one, in Grant county, state of Minnesota; and said bridge, when built, shall be kept in repair by said county and be forever free from toll.

SEC. 2. That said bridge shall be built under the direction of Ole Thompson, Ole W. Oleson and William Honson, who are hereby appointed commissioners for that purpose; and no part of said appro-
