

CHAPTER XCIX.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE TREASURER OF DAKOTA COUNTY TO OMIT THE COLLECTION OF A TAX HERETOFORE LEVIED AND CERTIFIED TO THE AUDITOR OF SAID COUNTY, AND BY HIM EXTENDED ON THE TAX ROLLS FOR COLLECTION OF TEN MILLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING A TOWN HALL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. The treasurer of the county of Dakota, in the state of Minnesota, is hereby fully authorized, empowered and strictly required to omit the collection of a special tax for the purpose of building a town hall, of ten mills heretofore levied and certified for collection by the board of supervisors of the township of West Saint Paul, in said county, on all the property within the limits of said township, not heretofore detached from said township and annexed to the city of Saint Paul, as the Sixth ward thereof.

SEC. 2. Nothing in this act shall be so construed as to interfere with the collection of said tax by the treasurer of Dakota county within the territory so annexed and constituting the Sixth ward of the city of Saint Paul, for the purpose of building said town hall.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER C.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TREASURER OF STEARNS COUNTY TO PAY OVER CERTAIN MONEY AND FUNDS.

WHEREAS, The town of Verdale, in the county of Stearns, has been united with and become a part of the town of Paynesville, in said county;

AND WHEREAS, There are public funds in the treasury of said county belonging to the said town of Verdale, therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the treasurer of the county of Stearns shall pay over to the town of Paynesville, in said county, all money and
