

CHAPTER CX.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO THE STATE FORESTRY ASSOCIATION, TO ENABLE SAID ASSOCIATION, TO GRANT PREMIUMS FOR TREE-PLANTING IN THIS STATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the general revenue fund, the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as many be needed, to the state forestry association, to enable said association to offer premiums for the planting of forest trees in the several counties of this state. Such sum as said association may deem advisable, not exceeding fifty dollars or less than twenty-five dollars, shall be offered as premiums to each of said counties, under rules and regulations to be adopted by the said association. The money hereby appropriated shall be used by said association for no other purpose whatever, and a report shall be made to the governor, to be transmitted to the next legislature, showing the disbursements of the same.

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be paid on state auditor's warrants, which shall be issued on the order of the secretary of said forestry association, approved by the president.

SEC. 3. No money shall be drawn under the provisions of this act until after the first day of November next.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXI.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE I. P. DURFEE FOR EXPENSES INCURRED BY HIM AS CONTESTANT IN THE CONTESTED ELECTION CASE OF I. P. DURFEE CONTESTANT AND GEORGE P. THOMPSON, RESPONDENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred and sixty-one and 50-100 dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse I. P. Durfee

To defray expenses of contested election case.

for money by him expended in the contested election case of I. P. Durfee, contestant, and George P. Thompson, respondent.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER CXII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE MATHIAS SEIBENALER FOR EXPENSES INCURRED BY HIM AS CONTESTANT IN THE CONTESTED ELECTION CASE OF MATHIAS SEIBENALER, CONTESTANT, AND CHARLES A. BAKER, RESPONDENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated to reimburse Mathias Seibenaler for expenses incurred him as contestant in the contested election case of Mathias Seibenaler, contestant, and Charles A. Baker, respondent, in the house of representatives, the sum of three hundred dollars. Appropriation for contested election expenses.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER CXIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF REIMBURSING CHARLES A. BAKER, IN CONTESTING ELECTION WITH MATHIAS SEIBENALER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated to Charles A. Baker out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse him for money expended in the contested election case of Appropriation for contested election expenses.
