CHAPTER LVIII.

AN ACT FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER SIXTY-THREE OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, RELATING TO THE POWERS OF THE SUPREME COURT.

Be it, enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter sixty-three of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 1. The supreme court has power to issue writs of error, certiorari, mandamus, prohibition, quo warranto, and also all other writs and processes, not especially provided for by law, to all courts of inferior jurisdiction, to corporations and to individuals, that are neccessary to the furtherance of justice and the execution of the laws; and shall be always open for the issuance and return of all such writs and processes, and for the hearing and determination of the same, and all matters therein involved, subject to such regulations and conditions as the court may prescribe. Any judge of said court may order the issuance of any such writ or process, and prescribe as to the service and return of the same.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and Whenact to take after its passage.

CHAPTER LIX.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER EIGHTY, GENERAL LAWS OF MINNESOTA FOR 1875, [BEING] AN ACT TO FIX THE TIMES FOR HOLDING GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE TWELFTH [UDICIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter eighty of the general laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-five, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 1. General terms of the district court shall hereafter be

held in the several counties composing the twelfth judicial district as follows:

County of Meeker. In the county of Meeker, on the third Tuesday of March and on the third Tuesday of October, in each year.

Kandiyohi.

In the county of Kandiyohi, on the fourth Tuesday of March and on the fourth Tuesday of October, in each year.

Swift.

In the county of Swift, on the second Tuesday of October, in each year.

Yellow Medicine

In the county of Yellow Medicine, on the second Tuesday of September, in each year.

Chippewa.

In the county of Chippewa, for the counties of Chippewa and Lac qui Parle, on the first Tuesday of June in each year.

Stevens.

In the county of Stevens, for the counties of Stevens, Big Stone and Traverse, on the third Tuesday of June in each year.

Wilkin.

In the county of Wilkin, on the second Tuesday of June in each year.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LX.

AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE TIME OF HOLDING GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE COUNTIES OF CLAY AND CROW WING.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Relating to said

SECTION I. That the general terms of the district court in and for the eleventh judicial district shall be held in the counties of Clay and Crow Wing at the times hereinafter prescribed, to-wit: In the county of Clay on the third Tuesday of April, and on the first Tuesday after second Monday in November in each year. In the county of Crow Wing on the fourth Tuesday of October in each year.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances, and all other papers and proceedings made returnable to the district court of the said several counties shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of said court, as the same are fixed by this act, and all continuances, appeals, motions, or other proceedings taken or made to or for any term of said court, shall be construed to

be made or taken to the terms of said court as fixed by this act.

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
