

CHAPTER LXXIV.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SEVEN OF CHAPTER ONE, OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, BEING SECTION SIXTEEN OF CHAPTER FOUR OF THE STATUTES AT LARGE, RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter one of the general statutes of the state of Minnesota is hereby amended to read as follows, viz.:

At all elections to be held under this chapter the polls shall be opened at nine o'clock in the forenoon and remain open until five o'clock in the afternoon, at which time the polls shall be closed. Time of elections.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER LXXV.

AN ACT REGULATING THE LIEN OF JUDGMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That whenever judgment has been entered in any suit or action, and a motion has been made and is pending for a new trial, or an appeal has been taken to the supreme court, the judgment shall cease to be a lien on the real estate of the defendant upon payment into court as security of such judgment, the amount thereof and such further sum as the court may by order direct, and determine to be sufficient to secure all interests and costs that will probably accrue pending such appeal. Judgment ceases to be lien.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
