and shall thereafter be endowed with all the rights, powers and duties therein prescribed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

### CHAPTER XII.

'AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF ATWATER, IN KANDIYOHI COUNTY.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the territory in Kandiyohi county commencing at the quarter stake between sections eleven and twelve running thence east forty rods, thence north two hundred rods, thence west two hundred rods, thence east one hundred and sixty rods to the place of beginning, all in township one hundred and nineteen, range thirty-three is hereby set apart for incorporation under the corporate name of the village of Atwater.

SEC. 2. Said village shall be incorporated and organized under the provisions of chapter one hundred and thirty-nine of the general laws

of eighteen hundred and seventy-five.

SEC. 3. E. A. D. Salter, A. C. Chittenden and Geo. F. McKenney are hereby appointed to issue notice of the first election of officers to be held in said village under the conditions of this act.

SEC. 4. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its

passage,

#### CHAPTER XIII.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALL.

# Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1 That sections number four (4) five (5) and nine (9) of township number one hundred and eleven (111) of range forty-one (41) in the town of Lake Marshall, county of Lyon, state of Minnesota,

be and the same hereby are set apart for incorporation and incorporated as a village under the corporate name and style of the "village of Marshall' to be organized pursuant to chapter one hundred and thirty-

nine (139) of the general laws of 1875.

SEC. 2. That C. A. Edwards, J. I. Reichers, Charles H. Whitney, C. F. Case, Orin Drake, John Ward and John A. Coleman of said town of Lake Marshall, be and the same are hereby designated to give notice of and for a meeting of the legal voters of said territory to organize said village, and elect officers pursuant to said chapter.

The territory constituting said village when organized shall be known and designated as road district number one of said

town of Lake Marshall.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

# CHAPTER XIV.

## AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF LEROY.

# Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. All that part of the county of Mower, in the state of Minnesota, known and described as the northwest quarter, and a strip thirty (30) rods in width from the north part of the north half of the southwest quarter of section thirty-four (34), and all that part of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section thirty-three (33), lying and being north of the main track of the Milwaukee & Saint Paul Railroad, all in township one hundred and one (101), north of range fourteen west, is hereby set apart and incorporated as the village of Leroy, under the provisions of chapter one hundered and thirtynine of the general laws of 1875, entitled, an act to provide for the incorporation of villages, and the amendments thereto.

SEC. 2. D. S. Fifield, W. L. Henderson and C. A. Roy, are hereby designated as the persons to carry out the provisions of section nine of the said chapter, and the secretary of state is hereby directed to issue his official notification of the passage of this act to said persons.

SEC. 3. In addition to the general powers conferred by the said chapter, the village council of said village shall also have power.

First.—To prescribe such additional duties for the officers of said

village as they may by ordinance direct.

Second.—To provide for the publication in a newspaper of notices and ordinances.

Third.—To appoint such additional special officers for said village as may be necessary therefor.
