SPECIAL LAWS

CHAPTER CLXVIII.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE SAMUEL GIBBONS, ADMINISTRATOR OF SETATE OF WILLIAM LIMON DECEASED, TO MAKE AN ADMINIS-TRATOR'S DEED, CONVEYING CERTAIN LANDS IN WABASHAW COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION I. That Samuel Gibbons, administrator of estate of William Limon deceased, be and hereby is authorized and empowered to make an administrator's deed, conveying the northwest quarter of section thirteen, township one hundred and nine, range thirteen, to Alexander Young, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns ; *Provided*, That said deed shall not be deemed or construed to have greater force or effect, or to convey greater or other interests than were conveyed by the original deed, now last granted by the said Samuel Gibbons to the said Alexander Young.

SEC. 2. That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CLXIX.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE A CERTAIN CONVEYANCE OF CEMETERY GROUNDS BY THE LAKE CRYSTAL CEMETERY ASSOCIATION TO THE VILLAGE OF LAKE CRYSTAL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That a certain deed of conveyance executed by the Lake Crystal cemetery association to the village of Lake Crystal, dated the twenty-first day of July, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and recorded in the office of the register of deeds of Blue Earth county, on the twenty-sixth day of January, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, at eleven o'clock A. M., in book number six of deeds, on page five hundred and forty-two, is hereby legalized and made valid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
