

CHAPTER CLXXXVIII.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE CEMETERY OF THE TOWN OF WOODVILLE, WASECA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. All purchases of land heretofore made or which may be hereafter made by the town of Woodville, in Waseca county, for cemetery purposes is hereby certified, confirmed and sanctioned.

SEC. 2. The supervisors of said town, at their first meeting after the annual town meeting next ensuing, shall appoint a board of three persons, who shall be called "The cemetery directors," one of whom shall be designated as president and shall hold his office for three years, one of whom shall be designated as secretary and shall hold his office for two years, and the other of whom shall be designated as treasurer and shall hold his office for one year, and each until his successor is appointed and qualified, and thereafter each year said board of supervisors, at their first meeting after their annual town meeting, shall appoint one director to succeed the one whose term of office then expires, who shall hold his office for the term of three years and until his successor is appointed and qualified. Any vacancy shall be filled by appointment by said supervisors for the unexpired term. *Provided,* That such trustees shall receive no compensation for their services, the secretary and treasurer shall give such bond as may be required by said supervisors.

SEC. 3. Said directors shall have full power and control over such lands held for cemetery purposes, and shall cause the same to be plotted and the plot thereof recorded in the office of the register of deeds of said county, and they or a majority of them in behalf of said town, may sell and convey any and all lots, to be kept and used for cemetery purposes only, and all conveyances of lots shall be signed, sealed and acknowledged by the president, and attested by the secretary of said board of directors. All moneys received on sale of lots, shall be expended by said directors in beautifying, improving or enlarging such cemetery.

SEC. 4. Said directors shall make and submit at each annual town meeting, a report in writing of the condition of such cemetery, the amounts received and expended, stating from whom received and for what and to whom paid.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
