

CHAPTER CCXXXIII.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF MANKATO TO ALTER THE NAME OF ANY STREET, AND TO NUMBER LOTS AND BLOCKS WHICH HAVE NO NUMBER.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Mankato shall have power in its discretion, within the limits of said city, to alter the name of any street; or to designate the name of any street heretofore or hereafter opened which is not named, and to number lots and blocks which have no number.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCXXXIV.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARI-BAULT, TO APPOINT FENCE VIEWERS WITHIN SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Faribault are hereby empowered to elect a board of three fence viewers whose term of office shall be one year, and until the election of their successors, and the council may fill all vacancies occurring in said board.

SEC. 2. The duties of such fence viewers shall be the same in relation to partition fences within the said city as are imposed by chapter 18 of the general statutes of this state of 1866, upon the supervisors of towns, and all the provisions of said chapter so far as they may be applicable, are hereby declared to be in force within said city.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
