## CHAPTER XCIX.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY THEREIN NAMED FROM SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER FORTY, AND ATTACH THE SAME TO DISTRICT NUMBER ELEVEN, ALL IN OLMSTED COUNTY.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory, viz: The east half of the east half, and the east half of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter all section twenty-five, township one hundred and six north, range twelve west, be and the same is hereby detached from school district number forty and attached to school district number eleven all in Olmsted county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.

## CHAPTER C.

AN ACT TO ADD CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT
OF THE CITY OF FARIBAULT.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the northeast quarter (1/4) of section one (1), in township one hundred and nine (109) north, of range twenty-one (21) west, be and the same is hereby declared to constitute a part and parcel of the school district of the city of Faribault.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.
