

CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SIX (126) OF TITLE FIVE (5) OF CHAPTER EIGHT (8) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX (1866), IN RELATION TO CONDITION OF COUNTY TREASURERS' BONDS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and twenty-six (126) of title five (5) of chapter eight (8) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six (1866), be and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows :

Amendment to chapter 8 of General Statutes, page 121.

Sec. 126. The county treasurer, before he enters upon the duties of his office, shall take the oath required by law, which oath shall be subscribed and certified on the back of the certificate of his election, and filed and recorded in the office of the register of deeds ; and he shall give bond, with two (2) or more sureties, freeholders, to be approved by the board of county commissioners, and in such sum as they direct, payable to the State of Minnesota, conditioned that such person shall faithfully execute the duties of his office, and for the safe keeping and paying over, according to law, of all moneys which come into his hands for State, county, township, school, road, bridge, poor, town, and all other purposes, which bond shall be filed and recorded in the office of register of deeds in said county.

Relating to the bonds of county treasurers, for faithful performance of duties.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
