CHAPTER 146.

AN ACT TO SUPPLY WATER FOR THE USE OF THE MINNE-SOTA STATE REFORM SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of one thousand five hundred Appropriation dollars (\$1,500), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be for water at and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, to procure a supply of water for the use of the Minnesota State Reform School, the same to be expended under the direction of the board of managers of said school.
