

## CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY TO MEET A DEFICIENCY  
IN THE BUILDING FUND OF THE MINNESOTA HOSPITAL  
FOR INSANE.*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of five thousand two hundred ninety-two dollars and seventy-eight cents (\$5,292.78-100) is hereby appropriated to meet the deficiency in the building fund of the Minnesota hospital for insane; and it is hereby made the duty of the State Auditor, on the presentation of a warrant drawn on him by the president and countersigned by the secretary of the board of trustees of that institution, to draw a warrant on the State Treasurer for the same.

Deficiency in building fund.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY TO CARRY INTO EFFECT THE ACT APPROVED MARCH FIFTH (5), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR (1874), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE RECEPTION AND DISPOSITION OF FISH AND SPAWN ALLOTTED TO THIS STATE BY THE UNITED STATES," AND THE ACT AMENDATORY THEREOF, APPROVED MARCH NINTH (9TH), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE (1875).

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the general revenue fund, the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), to be expended during the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), and the like sum during the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878),
