

CHAPTER 168.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR REPAIRS ON THE
STATE PRISON.*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The sum of one thousand two hundred and eighty-eight dollars and forty-five cents (\$1,288.45) is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to James L. Spink, in payment for putting in water pipes in the State prison during the summer of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six (1876).

CHAPTER 169.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE OF MINNESOTA FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX (1876).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated, viz.:

Appropriation

For per diem and mileage of Stephen Miller, as elector of President and Vice-President of the United States, fifty dollars and ten cents (\$50.10).

For per diem of C. K. Davis, as elector of President and Vice President of the United States, six dollars (\$6).

For per diem and mileage of Hans Mattson, as elector of President and Vice President of the United States, thirty dollars (\$30).
