

## CHAPTER 171.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE C. G. EDWARDS FOR EXPENSES INCURRED BY HIM AS RESPONDENT IN THE CONTESTED ELECTION CASE OF WILLIAM MEIGHEN, CONTESTANT, AGAINST C. G. EDWARDS, RESPONDENT.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of fourteen hundred and eighty-three dollars and sixty-five cents (\$1,400.65) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse C. G. Edwards for his expenses in the contested election case of Wm. Meighen against C. G. Edwards, respondent. Contested election expenses.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

## CHAPTER 172.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR ENLARGING THE GROUNDS OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be expended in enlarging the grounds of the State University, by the purchase or condemnation of lands abutting upon the present grounds of the University, the same to be paid on warrants drawn by the president and countersigned by the treasurer of the board of regents; and on the presentation of such warrants to the State Auditor it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the State Treasurer for like amounts; such money to be expended under the direction of the board of regents of the State University.
