CHARTER 35.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIXTEEN (16) OF CHAPTER EIGHTY-EIGHT (88) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX (1866), RELATING TO ATTORNEYS AT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section sixteen (16) of chapter eighty. Section 16, chapter 88, eight (88) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hun-General Laws dred and sixty-six (1866), be and the same is hereby amended amended.

so as to read as follows:

When an attorney refuses to deliver over money or papers Relating to to a person from or for whom he has received them, in the received of professional employment, whether in an action or over moneys. not, he may be required by an order of the court in which an action, if any, was prosecuted, or if no action was prosecuted, then by order of the district court of the county in which such attorney resides, or by the supreme court, to do so within a specified time, or show cause why he should not be punished for contempt.

CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FIFTY (50), CHAPTER NINETY-FIVE (95), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, RELATING TO THE BURNING OF PRAIRIE GRASS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section fifty (50) of chapter ninety-five (95) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred
