

CHAPTER 47.

[The law of 1872, as amended herein, is the same as proposed amendment.]

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBDIVISION ELEVEN (11) OF SECTION THREE (3) OF TITLE TWO (2) OF CHAPTER ONE (1) OF THE GENERAL LAWS FOR THE YEAR A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO (1872), ENTITLED, "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A RECIPROCAL GENERAL INSURANCE LAW FOR THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND TO REVISE AND AMEND THE LAWS OF SAID STATE RELATING TO HOME AND FOREIGN INSURANCE COMPANIES."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Relates to the per cent. of impairment of capital stock.

SECTION 1. That subdivision eleven (11) of section three (3) of title two (2) of chapter one (1) of the General Laws for the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two (1872), be and the same hereby is amended by striking out the word "twenty" in the fifth line of said subdivision, and inserting in place of the word so stricken out, the word "ten."

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 48.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THIRTY-SEVEN (37) OF CHAPTER FIVE (5) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE (1873), RELATING TO ROADS, CARTWAYS AND BRIDGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section thirty-seven (37) of chapter five (5) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873), is hereby amended by adding thereto the following, to-wit:

Relating to filing of awards on opening roads.

And after such order is confirmed, and such order, together with the award, has been recorded by such town clerk, the same shall be sent by him to the county auditor, who shall file and preserve all such papers thus transmitted to him.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
