CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE BOUNDARIES OF CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN THE COUNTY OF RICE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the north half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the north half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of section nineteen (19) of town one hundred and ten (110) of range twenty (20) west, situated in Rice county, be and the same hereby is detached from school district number twenty-five (25) and added to independent school district number one (1), in the said county of Rice.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER TWENTY-ONE (21), OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TO ORGANIZE UNDER THE TITLE OF AN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That school district number twenty one (21), in the county of Washington, is hereby authorized to organize under the title of an independent school district, in the same manner and with the same powers to act under the general laws as may now be provided for incorporated villages and school districts containing a population exceeding five hundred (500) inhabitants.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
