CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO SET OFF AND LOCATE CERTAIN LANDS FROM SCHOOL DISTRICTS NUMBER EIGHTY-TWO (82) AND NUMBER ELEVEN (11) IN DAKOTA AND GOODHUE COUNTIES, TO DISTRICT NUMBER SIXTY-SIX (66), IN DAKOTA COUNTY."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the north-west quarter (\frac{1}{4}) of section number twelve (12), and also the south-west quarter (\frac{1}{4}) of section number one (1), both in township number one hundred and twelve (112) of range number eighteen (18), in the county of Dakota, in the State of Minnesota, and now attached and belonging to school district number eighty-two (82), in said Dakota county, jointly with school district number eleven (11), in Goodhue county, Minnesota, are hereby detached and set off from said school districts numbers eighteen (18) and eleven (11), in Dakota and Goodhue counties, and are hereby attached to and included in school district number sixty-six (66), in said county of Dakota.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act

are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER SIXTY-TWO (62), IN WINONA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That sections thirty-five and thirty-six, in town of Watopa, Wabashaw county, be attached to school district number sixty-two, Winona county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
