

CHAPTER 114.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE FORMATION AND ACTS OF THE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF DULUTH, TO PROVIDE A RECORD THEREOF, AND FIX ITS BOUNDARIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the adoption of title three (3) of chapter thirty-six (36) of the General Statutes of Minnesota, by the inhabitants of the city of Duluth, and the formation of the independent school district of Duluth, on the second (2d) day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy (1870), in accordance with the provisions of said title, and all the acts and proceedings of the board of education of said district, be and the same is hereby in all respects confirmed and legalized.

SEC. 2. That the present clerk of said independent school district of Duluth, be and he is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to make a record of the proceedings of said meeting of the second (2d) day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy (1870), which record shall be attested by the oaths of at least three (3) persons who were present at said meeting; and that such record so made shall be incorporated with the record of said district in its proper order, and shall be taken and considered a legal record of said meeting, and shall be received and read in evidence in all courts and places without further proof.

SEC. 3. The territory of the city and village of Duluth, as the same now is, or hereafter may be limited and defined, and no other, shall constitute the said school district.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
