west, containing one hundred and twenty-one and forty-five one-hundredth (121 45-100th) acres, in exchange for lots five (5) and six (6), in section fifteen (15), township one hundred and ten (110), range twenty-six (26), containing one hundred and ten and thirty one-hundredth (110 30-100th) acres.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 143.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR OF RAMSEY COUNTY TO COLLECT CERTAIN TAXES IN THE SIXTH WARD OF THE CITY OF ST. PAUL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the auditor of Ramsey county to advertise and enforce the collection, according to law, at the first annual sale held in said county, all unpaid taxes for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874), and the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, (1872), and prior years, in the sixth (6th) ward of the city of St. Paul, formerly set apart from Dakota county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
