this act shall be paid into the treasury of said Jackson county, for the use and benefit of the common schools of said county.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE FISHING WITH NETS AND SEINES IN CERTAIN LAKES IN CROW LAKE TOWNSHIP, IN STEARNS COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That any and all persons be and hereby are authorized and allowed to take fish with nets or seines from any of the following named lakes in the town of Crow Lake, in Stearns county, to-wit: Crow Lake, Fish Lake, and Tamarack Lake.

Provided, that no person shall be authorized or allowed to use nets or seines with meshes less than one and one-fourth $(1\frac{1}{2})$ inches square.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
