### CHAPTER 164.

## AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWN SITE OF DOUGLAS, IN STEVENS COUNTY.

# Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the town site of Douglas, in the county of Stevens, in said State, as the same appears on the recorded plat of said town site, be and the same hereby is changed to the name of Donnelly; and the plat of said town site shall hereafter be known and designated as the plat of the town site of Donnelly.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

#### CHAPTER 165.

### AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF MARION LAKE TOWNSHIP, IN OTTER TAIL COUNTY, TO PERHAM.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the town of Marion Lake, in Otter Tail county, be and is hereby changed to the name of Perham.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
