

## CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTS OF JAMES D. SLATER, AS GUARDIAN OF JAMES ROBINSON, THOMAS ROBINSON, AND WILLIAM ROBINSON, MINORS, IN MAKING SALE OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE OF SAID MINORS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sale made on the second (2d) day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873), by James D. Slater, as guardian of James Robinson, Thomas Robinson, and William Robinson, minors, of certain lands of said minors, situate in the county of Goodhue, in this State, and which sale was made under and by virtue of the license of the probate court of said county, theretofore granted to said James D. Slater, together with all proceedings of said guardian in making such sale, be and the same hereby are declared and made legal and valid in all respects and for all purposes whatever.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 190.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF THE TOWN SUPERVISORS OF MUNSON, IN CHANGING AND LAYING OUT OF THE STATE ROAD FROM ST. CLOUD, IN STEARNS COUNTY, TO BRECKENRIDGE, IN WILKIN COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the acts and proceedings of the board of town supervisors of the town of Munson, in the county of Stearns, in changing the State and county road from St. Cloud, in Stearns county, to Breckenridge, in Wilkin county, in the village of Richmond, town of Munson, county of Stearns, are hereby legalized and made lawful acts, as if the change had been made by the board of county commissioners of said Stearns county.
