CHAPTER 193.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STERLING, IN THE COUNTY OF BLUE EARTH, STATE OF MINNESOTA, IN APPROPRIATING MONEY TO PAY FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF GRASSHOPPER EGGS, AND ALL ACTS DONE BY THE SUPERVISORS OF SAID TOWN IN PURSUANCE THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the action of a special town meeting of the township of Sterling, in the county of Blue Earth, held on the eleventh (11th) day of September, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six (1876), in appropriating money to pay for the destruction of grasshopper eggs, and all acts of the supervisors of said town done in pursuance thereof, are hereby legalized and made lawful acts.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

· its passage.
