CHAPTER 194.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF LAC QUI PARLE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the proceedings of the county commissioners of the county of Lac qui Parle had in the division of school district number one (1) and in the formation of school district number eight (8), be and the same are hereby legalized.

after its passage.

CHAPTER 195.

AN ACTITO LEGALIZE THE ACTS OF COMMISSIONERS SURVEYING AND LOCATING A STATE ROAD FROM BECKER STATION, IN SHERBURNE COUNTY, TO SAUK RAPIDS, IN BENTON COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the acts of the commissioners in surveying and locating a State road from Becker station, in Sherburne county, to Sauk Rapids, in Benton county, pursuant to an act of the Legislature, approved March first (1st), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six (1876), are hereby legalized; and the said road, as surveyed and located by said commissioners, is hereby declared to be a legal highway.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
