

lands, franchises and property of said company shall thereupon be forfeited as provided in this act.

SEC. 4. Said railroad company, its successors or assigns, shall at all times transport over its line of railroad, passengers and freight, at just and reasonable rates, and shall make no unjust or unreasonable discrimination respecting the same.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 219.

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR THE REDEMPTION OF LANDS SOLD FOR TAXES FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE (1873), IN DAKOTA AND SIBLEY COUNTIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the period fixed by law for the redemption of real estate in the counties of Dakota and Sibley, in this State, upon which the taxes of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873) remain due and unpaid, which period of redemption expires in the county of Sibley January eighteenth (18th), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), and in the county of Dakota January fifteenth (15th), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, be and the same is hereby extended for the period of one (1) year from and after the said fifteenth (15th) day and eighteenth (18th) of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877); during which time the owners of said property shall be entitled to redeem the same in the same manner that they could prior to said fifteenth (15th) and eighteenth (18th) of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
