CHAPTER 121.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON STATE BONDS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of thirty-five thousand (\$35,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury belonging to the State interest fund, to be expended in payment of interest on State bonds.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 122

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE WADENA COUNTY FOR EXPENSES INCURRED BY SMALL POX.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the county of Wadena, for the purpose of reimbursing said county for expenses incurred by small pox cases during the summer of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, (1877).
