## CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER SIXTY-FOUR (64) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR (1874,) RELATING TO INSANE PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section thirteen (13) of Chapter forty-eight (48); of the General Statutes, as amended by Chapter sixty-four (64) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four (1874), be amended by inserting the words "or an insane person," after the word "minor," in the third line of said section as amended.

Relating to bar of dower when husband is insane.

## CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE (1) HUNDRED AND TWENTY (121) ONE OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE YEAR EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE (1875).

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred and twenty-one, (121) of the General Laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-five, (1875) is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
