CHAPLER 48.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWELVE (12) OF CHAPTER SEVENTY-FOUR (74), LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877), RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twelve (12) of chapter seventyfour (74) of the General Laws of the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), be and the same

hereby amended so as to read af follows:

Section 12. The county commissioners of the several counties in this State, may form new school districts, alter the boundaries of districts, or unite districts, upon the petition of a majority of the freeholders who are legal voters, residing in each district to be affected thereby, and upon the written approval of the county superintendent endorsed upon such petition.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CLERKS OF TOWNS AND CITIES, AND RECORDERS OF VILLAGES, IN THIS STATE, TO ADMINISTER OATHS AND TAKE ACKNOWLEDGMENTS OF INSTRUMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the Town Clerks of the several towns, City Clerks of all cities, and Recorders of all villages, in this State, are hereby authorized to administer all oaths and take all acknowledgements of instruments, authorized or required by law.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.
