

CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER SEVEN, OF WINNEBAGO CITY, IN FARIBAULT COUNTY, AND ATTACH THE SAME TO SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER THIRTEEN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the north-east quarter of section one (1), in township one hundred and three (103), north of range twenty-eight (28) west, be and the same is hereby detached from independent school district of Winnebago City, and attached to school district number thirteen (13), in Faribault county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO CREATE A SCHOOL DISTRICT OUT OF CERTAIN TERRITORY LYING IN THE TOWNS OF BELLE PLAINE AND HELENA, IN THE COUNTY OF SCOTT, BEING CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TEN (110) OF SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of said act be amended by inserting before the words "of section" in nineteenth line of said section the following: and the north-west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the north-west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
