

CHAPTER 240.

AN ACT TO MAKE IT LAWFUL TO CATCH FISH WITH NETS IN
KANDIYOHI COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That it shall be lawful for any person at all times to catch fish with nets in which the meshes are not less than one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) inches across, in all the lakes in the county of Kandiyohi.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 241.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER FIFTEEN (15) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877), BEING AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF SHIELDSVILLE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter fifteen (15) of the special laws of the State of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), approved March fifth (5th), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), being "an act to incorporate the village of Shieldsville," in the county of Rice, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
