

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT AMENDATORY OF CHAPTER TWENTY-EIGHT (28) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT (1868), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO REDUCE AN ACT INCORPORATING THE TOWN OF ST. CLOUD, AND TO AMEND THE SAME, AND TO INCORPORATE THE CITY OF ST. CLOUD."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section three (3) of chapter four (4) of an act of the Legislature for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-eight (1868), entitled "An act to reduce the act incorporating the town of St. Cloud * * * * and to amend the same, and to incorporate the City of St. Cloud," approved March sixth (6th), one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight (1868), is hereby amended by adding to the first subdivision of said section three (3), the following words, to-wit: "And provided further, that the said common council shall have the exclusive right to license persons to vend, deal in and dispose of spirituous, vinous, malt or fermented liquors within the limits of said city, and persons so licensed shall not be required to obtain a license from the board of county commissioners, but shall comply with the requirements and be subject to all the penalties as provided by the statutes of the State."

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER TWO (2) OF CHAPTER FIFTEEN (15) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO (1872), AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, IN THE COUNTY OF WABASHAW.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter two (2) of chapter fifteen (15) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two (1872), be amended so as to read as follows:
