CHAPTER 97.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWN OF BELLE PLAINE, IN SCOTT COUNTY, TO ISSUE BONDS FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. [That] the supervisors of the town of Belle Plaine, in Scott county, in said State, are hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said town, with interest coupons attached, to the amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), for the purpose of constructing a free wagon bridge across the Minnesota river, at or near Grove street, in said town, and as may be adjudged and determined by a competent engineer, as the most practicable and economical.

Provided, That no bonds shall be issued by said board of supervisors until a majority of the legal voters of the township of Belle Plaine, voting at a special election legally called according to law, shall decide in favor of the issue of said bonds.

SEC. 2. Said bonds may be issued at any time within one (1) year after the passage of this act, and shall be made payable within the time of ten (10) years after their issue, and shall draw interest not to exceed ten (10) per cent per annum.

SEC. 3. Said bonds shall be signed by the chairman of the board of supervisors and countersigned by the town clerk of said town.

SEC 4. The supervisors of said town are hereby authorized, empowered and required to provide for the payment of interest and principal of said bonds, as the same mature, by the levying of sufficient taxes therefor.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 98.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION-ERS OF ROCK COUNTY TO ISSUE BONDS TO FUND ITS FLOAT-ING INDEBTEDNESS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the board of county commissioners of the county of Rock is hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said county, for the purpose of liquidating and funding.
