CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWELVE (12) OF CHAPTER SEVENTY-FOUR (74) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877), AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER FORTY-EIGHT (48) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section twelve (12) of chapter seventy-four (74) of the General Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), as amended by chapter forty-eight (48) of the General Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is

hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 12. The Board of County Commissioners of the several counties in this State may form new school districts, alter the boundaries of districts, or unite districts upon a petition of a majority of the freeholders who are legal voters, residing in each district to be affected thereby. *Provided*, That before final action on such petition by said Board, the same shall be submitted to the County Superintendent of Schools of such county, who shall speedily report the same to said board, with his opinion in writing, as to the propriety of granting such petition.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.

CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER EIGHT (8) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES RELATING TO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Chapter 8 of the general statutes awended. Section 1. That section ninety-six (96) of chapter eight (8) of the General Statutes be amended by adding at the end thereof the following provisions: And the county commissioners shall cause their official proceedings of each session to be published in some newspaper printed and published in their
