county; provided, that in the counties of Hennepin and Ramsey the proceedings may be printed in a daily paper and one weekly paper printed and published at the respective county seats of said counties, and in all cases in designating the paper or papers, the character and value thereof as a medium for getting the proceedings before the tax-payers of said counties respectively be taken into consideration; [which publications shall be let by contract to the lowest bidder.]

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.

## CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FIFTY-FOUR (54) OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES AS AMENDED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section fifty-four (54) of chapter thirty-four (34) of the general statutes as heretofore amended, be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 54. Any number of persons, not less than three, may associate themselves and become incorporated for the purpose of establishing and conducting colleges, seminaries, lyceums, or any scientific, medical, legal, agricultural, benevolent or missionary society, fire department association, cemetery association, or any Masonic, Odd Fellow, Good Templar, Temple of Honor, or similar societies for the promotion of temperance or social or moral reform; or any society for the purpose of instruction or mutual improvement, in any art or science, or for literary or social culture, as provided herein.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
