

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER TWENTY-TWO (22) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO (1872), ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROMOTE THE SCIENCE OF MEDICINE AND SURGERY IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section four (4) of chapter twenty-two (22) of the General Laws of the State for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two (1872), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

Sec. 4. Every person who unlawfully shall exhume, remove or carry off the remains or any part of the remains of any deceased person, or who shall deliver up such remains in violation of or contrary to any or all of the provisions contained in the first section of this act, and every person who shall receive said remains, knowing the same to have been exhumed, removed, carried off or delivered contrary to any or all of the provisions of this act, shall, each and every one of such persons, be deemed guilty of a felony, and shall on conviction be imprisoned in the State prison for a term not exceeding four (4) years.

SEC. 2. All acts and part of acts inconsistent with this act is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIXTEEN (16) OF CHAPTER ONE (1) OF CHAPTER SEVENTY-FOUR (74) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877) RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section sixteen (16) of chapter one (1) being chapter seventy-four of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877,) relating to public schools be amended by changing the proviso commenc-
