

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWLVEE (12) OF CHAPTER TEN (10) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX (1866) RELATING TO NOTICE CHANGING TIME OF HOLDING TOWN MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Chapter 10 of
the general
statutes
amended.

SECTION 1. That section twelve (12) of chapter ten (10) of the General Statutes of 1866, be and the same is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

Provided, That before any change of place of holding town meetings is made, notice of such contemplated change may be given by any member of the town board to the Town Clerk who shall in his regularly printed or written notices as provided herein above incorporated the special notice of the contemplated change of place of holding said town meeting.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 48.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIXTEEN (16) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-NINE (139) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE (1875) RELATING TO THE ORGANIZATION OF VILLAGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Chapter 139 of
the general
laws of 1875
amended.

SECTION 1. Section sixteen (16) of chapter one hundred and thirty-nine (139) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875), entitled an act to provide for the organization of villages in the State of Minnesota is hereby amended by adding to the end of said section the following words, to wit: And shall be paid over by the County Treasurer, when collected, to the Village Treasurer upon the warrant of the County Auditor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
