

SEC. 3. All judicial proceedings now pending in, and all recognizances, writs and proceedings returnable to the District Court of the county of Cottonwood from the county of Murray aforesaid, are hereby made pending in and returnable to the District Court in said county of Murray, and all papers on file, with the Clerk of the District Court of Cottonwood county, pertaining to such proceeding from Murray county, shall be transferred to the clerk of said county in Murray county, and all records in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of said Cottonwood county may be transcribed by the Clerk of the District Court of said Murray county, and such transcription of records shall thereafter be of the same force and effect as though the same had been originally made in the Clerk's office of said Murray county.

SEC. 4. This act shall be a general law and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 58.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE TIME OF HOLDING TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE COUNTY OF COTTONWOOD.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. General terms of the District Court shall be held in and for the county of Cottonwood, commencing on the first (1st) Tuesday after the fourth (4th) day of July, in each year.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
