CHAPTER CXCII.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HEN-NEPIN COUNTY TO AUDIT AND PAY THE CLAIMS OF S. F. PECK-HAM AND L. W. PECK.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the county commissioners of Hennepin county be and are hereby authorized to audit and allow to be paid out of the public funds of said county, the claims of S. F. Peckham, chemist, and of L. W. Peck, professor of physics, for services as experts and expenses incident thereto, required of them by coroner P. Nelson, in the inquest held by him over the bodies of the persons killed in the so-called explosion of the Washburn A mill in Minneapolis, in May, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, the whole amount paid not to exceed in the aggregate the sum of one hundred and thirty-five dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER CXCIII.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LYNDALE RAILWAY COMPANY TO CONNECT LAKES CALHOUN AND HARRIET BY CANAL AND RUN BOATS THEREON.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The Lyndale Railway company, its successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to purchase or construct a steamboat or boats, or boat or boats propelled by other power, and to use, navigate and run the same, in carrying passengers and freight for hire, on Lake Calhoun and Lake Harriet, and through the canal herein authorized to be constructed to connect the same, all being in Hennepin county, state of Minnesota, and to
