

CHAPTER CCXLIV.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE PROCEEDINGS HAD AT A SPECIAL SCHOOL MEETING IN THE COUNTY OF BROWN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the proceedings had and held at a special school meeting in district number nine, in the county of Brown on the fifteenth day of November, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven are hereby legalized and made valid, and all actions taken thereafter and hereafter pertaining solely to matters of school shall not be impaired or annulled by reason of such proceedings.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCXLV.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE BONDS OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER THIRTY-EIGHT IN LE SUEUR COUNTY, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the action of the voters of school district number thirty-eight in the county of Le Sueur, at a special school meeting held therein on the fourteenth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, whereby the said district voted to issue the bonds of said district in an amount not to exceed the sum of twelve hundred dollars, and the bonds of said district issued in pursuance thereof be, and the same are hereby legalized and confirmed.

SEC. 2. The trustees of said district are hereby authorized and empowered to levy annually upon the property of said district a tax of three hundred dollars, for the purpose of paying the principal and interest of said bonds.

SEC. 3. That none of the territory now included in the boundaries of said district shall be detached from said school district until the said bonds are fully paid.

SEC. 4. This act shall not be amended or repealed by any act general or special, unless the act amending or repealing the same shall directly refer to this act.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
