CHAPTER CCLXI.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO, CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND SIX OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT, RELATING TO THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CATTLE AND OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS IN THE COUNTY OF RICE, STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Sec. 1. That section two, chapter two hundred and six of the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight is hereby amended by striking out

"Provided, That nothing herein contained shall apply to the townships of Forest, Wheatland, Webster and Erin, in said county

of Rice.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCLXII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND TEN OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT, TO PREVENT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CATTLE OR OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS IN THE FIRST COMMISSIONER'S DISTRICT OF WILKIN COUNTY OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow any cattle, horses, mules, sheep or swine, owned by such person or persons, or of which such person or persons have control or may be in possession, to run at large upon public highways or upon the lands of any other person or persons in the first and second commissioners' districts of the county of Wilkin, state of Minnesota, during any season of the year, unless they are carefully herded.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
