

CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A DEPUTY CLERKSHIP IN THE CLERK OF [THE] SUPREME COURT'S OFFICE, AND FIXING THE SALARY THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The Clerk of Supreme Court is hereby empowered to employ in his office a deputy clerk, who shall receive for his services the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per annum, and the sum aforesaid is hereby annually appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund for the payment of said salary.

Deputy clerk.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARY OF CHIEF CLERK IN THE STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the Chief Clerk in the State Auditor's office, for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), and annually thereafter, shall be two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

Auditor's chief clerk—salary.

SEC. 2. That subdivision seventeen (17) of section ten (10) of chapter seven (7) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifteen hundred" (1,500) and inserting the words two thousand (2,000) in lieu thereof.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
