

## CHAPTER 170.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR REBUILDING THE NORTH WING OF THE FIRST HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREIN NAMED.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

First hospital  
for insane.

SECTION 1. That the following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the State Institutions Fund and not otherwise appropriated, for the following purposes:

For rebuilding the north wing of the First Hospital for the Insane, ninety-thousand dollars (\$90,000).

Rebuilding  
and refitting.

For furnishing north wing of the First Hospital for the Insane, twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000).

For heating, plumbing and gas fitting the north wing of the First Hospital for the Insane, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

For repairs in the center building and south wing of First Hospital for the Insane, five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

For water supply, outside protection from fire, pipes, hydrants and hose, fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).

For remodeling the basement of the south wing on fire-proof plan, and also the center building of the First Hospital for the Insane, fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).

*Provided*, that the warrants of the State Auditor on the State Treasurer for the above amount of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) shall not be drawn during the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881).

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
