

CHAPTER 174.

AN ACT TO FIX AND APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SALARY OF THE STATE LIBRARIAN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) be and the same is hereby appropriated annually, out of any moneys in the treasury belonging to the General Revenue Fund for the payment of the salary of the State Librarian, which annual salary is hereby fixed at the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000). State Librarian.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEYS TO THE STATE UNIVERSITY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. There is hereby [annually] appropriated to the University of Minnesota the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the term of six (6) years, to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be annually placed at the disposal of the Regents of said University, for the objects and purposes hereinafter set forth. State University.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to faithfully expend the sums of money herein appropriated, for the erection of buildings, including legitimate appurtenances, and the purchase of furniture, including steam, water and lighting fixtures, apparatus, books, instruments and other appropriate appliances of instruction, and for no other purposes whatsoever, and no contracts shall be made in any one year in excess of the appropriation for such year. Duty of board of regents.

SEC. 3. There shall be erected the following buildings, in such order and at such relative cost as the Board of Regents may determine, to-wit:
