AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PRO-MOTE IMMIGRATION," APPROVED MARCH SEVENTH (7tm), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section two (2) of chapter seventy-six (76) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), be and the same is hereby amended, by inserting the words "and circulars," after the word "pamphlet," in the third (3d) and eight (8th) lines of said section.

CHAPTER 35.
