

## CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO, (172), CHAPTER EIGHT, (8,) GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO SALARY OF COUNTY TREASURERS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. Section one hundred and seventy-two (172), of chapter eight (8), of General Statutes [of] one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), is hereby amended by inserting after the words "school lands," in the seventh (7th) line the following: "to be paid him upon the warrant of the State Auditor."

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 39.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FORTY-ONE (41), CHAPTER ONE (1), OF GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO FEES OF MESSENGERS FOR CARRYING ELECTION RETURNS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. Section forty-one (41), of chapter one (1), of General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: All claims for fees for carrying election returns shall be audited and allowed by the board of County Commissioners of the proper county, in the same manner as other claims are allowed, and may be paid immediately thereafter, upon the warrant of the County Auditor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
