

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX (166) AND ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN (167), TITLE THREE (3) OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34), GENERAL STATUTES ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER THIRTY (30), GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879), RELATING TO CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and sixty-six (166), title three (3), chapter thirty-four (34), General Statutes one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) as amended by chapter thirty (30), General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), is hereby amended so as [to] read as follows:

SEC. 166. Any number of persons not less than three (3), may associate themselves and become incorporated for the purpose of establishing and conducting colleges, seminaries, lyceums, library associations, or any scientific, medical, legal, agricultural, benevolent or missionary society, fire department association, cemetery association, or any Masonic, Odd-Fellow, Good Templar, Temple of Honor, Division of the Sons of Temperance, or similar societies for the promotion of temperance, or social or moral reform, or any society for the purpose of instruction or mutual improvement in any art or science, or for literary or social culture, as provided herein.

SEC. 2. That subdivision fourth (4th) of section one hundred and sixty-seven (167) of said title three (3), is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following: *Provided*, that societies for the promotion of temperance, or social or moral reform, may hold their annual meetings for the election of officers and the transaction of other business, at such time and place in the State as a majority of the members thereof may by vote determine, and any temperance or other such society heretofore organized may hold their annual meetings at any time or place so determined, anything in its original articles of incorporation or by-laws to the contrary notwithstanding.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
