STATE LOANS.

The temporary loans negotiated from time to time, have been paid, with the exception of \$5,696 65 borrowed in pursuance of a joint resolution of the Legislature, for the purpose of meeting the demands of the State text-book contractor.

INTEREST ON STATE DEPOSITS.

The income from this source during the fiscal year amounts to \$9,281 63, an increase of \$2,469 15 against last year. Of this amount \$113 00 was used for paying interest on invested funds, and the balance of \$9,168 63 was covered into the revenue fund.
